River Thames Challenge

In Memory of Tony Barnett

We have swum the Northern Line and followed Phileas Fogg around the world in past charity events. This year we are going to swim the Thames.

The swim will begin at Tower Bridge heading west towards the M25 and beyond. The distance will be calculated by how many lengths are swum during the sessions that you attend. There will be different targets depending on which squad you are in and whether you are single or multi session swimmer.

We will be starting the event off with a 'mile swim week' starting on the 9th October. You will be able to attempt the mile swim on either the Sunday, Wednesday or Thursday of that week. The mile will be added to your total distance swam between 9th October and 7th December 2011.

This is a sponsored swim and the sponsorship forms will be handed out to all participants. To start the ball rolling we will be asking for an entrance fee of £3. This will then be taken off of your sponsorship money once it has been collected.

We are running the event this year in memory of Tony Barnett who sadly died this year after a long struggle with Cancer. Tony first became involved with Broomfield when his children Simon and Jo joined the club in the early 1980's. Along with Angela his wife he soon joined the masters section of the club and remained a member until he passed away.

Money raised this year will go 2/3rd towards the North London Hospice that helped Tony so much and 1/3rd towards equipment for the club.
